June-November 2008



There are now 22 new toilets in Bhattedande village, 6 biogas and 16 septic systems.

To quote Mr Balram Ram Tamang, one of the village elders, since 1987 *“the people from the village has being requested for the toilet program to the municipality as well as different national and international non government organisations. The people have only received the promises but the program never came.”*

Now, 18 months into this project, he tells us *“I am very happy and delighted with this development work happening for the people of this village, likewise all the village people are also very happy to see the development in the village.”*
